Rep. Hein gave a summary of the bill and an analogy

Discussion of amendment to the bill

Rep. Wolfe raised concerns about the waiver denial, and stated her request that there be an added amendment to change the language of the bill

The amendment was discussed, Rep Hein stated his reasons against it. Rep stated stated his approval

Rep Wolfe called for a vote for the amendment

vote failed, the amendment was not passed

The bill was further discussed. The question asked about the criteria allowed for a waiver for small gas stations to not have to make changes to provide E15 fuel. Rep Wolfe and Rep Jacoby expressed their concerns with the bill as it was.
