Senator Edler introduced [SSB 3066](#) and gave opening comments on the bill.

Seeing none, [SSB 3043](#) was called to a voice vote.

[SSB 3043](#) passed unanimously on a short form voice vote.

Chairman Edler states [SSB 3043](#) moves to the Calendar under Rule 40.

Chairman Senator Edler recognized Senator Costello for consideration of [SSB 3077](#).

Subcommittee report was provided. Senator Costello states there is an amendment.

Chairman Senator Edler recognized Senator Costello for opening remarks on bill and Amendment 2809. Senator Costello gave remarks on amendment.

Chairman Edler opened the floor to discussion on the amendment.

Seeing none, Amendment 2809 came to a voice vote.

Amendment 3077.2809 passed unanimously on a short form voice vote.

Seeing none, a voice vote was called for [SSB 3077](#) as amended.
