Chairwoman Meyer turned the Chair over to Representative Bradley.

Chairman Bradley recognized Representative Ann Meyer for [HF 2010](#): *A bill for an Act relating to experimental treatments for terminally ill person, and including effective date provisions.*

Chairman Bradley recognized Representative Meyer for opening remarks on amendment 2010.2744. The amendment passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed with a vote of 13 Ayes (Representatives Meyer, Bradley, Andrews, Bacon, Bergan, Boden, Bush, Dolecheck, Fry, Jeneary, Lundgren, Moore, Osmundson) 7 Nays (Representatives Wessel-Kroeschell, Anderson, Brown-Powers, Ehlert, Forbes, Mascher, Sunde), and 1 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairman Bradley recognized Representative Ann Meyer for [HSB 539](#): *A bill for an Act relating to the minimum age requirements for employees, substitutes, and volunteers working at a child care facility.*
