Senator Edler provided the subcommittee report, introduced [SSB 3102](#) and gave comments on the bill.

Senator Costello recognized Senator Mathis who made comments and asked Senator Edler a question.

Senator Costello recognized Senator Edler who responded to Senator Mathis. Senator Mathis gave further comments.

Seeing no further discussion, Senator Costello recognized Senator Edler for closing comments on [SSB 3102](#). Senator Edler provided closing comments and moved the bill.

[SSB 3102](#) passed unanimously on a short form voice vote and moves to the calendar under Rule 40.

Senator Costello recognized Senator Edler for [SSB 3105](#).

Senator Edler provided the subcommittee report and gave opening comments on the bill.

Senator Costello opened the floor to discussion.

Senator Costello recognized Senator Jochum who asked Senator Edler to yield.

Senator Edler agreed and Senator Jochum asked a question. Senator Edler responded.

Senator Jochum gave further comments.

Senator Costello recognized Senator Trone Garriott who made comments.

Senator Costello recognized Senator Bolkcom who made comments.

Seeing no further discussion, Senator Costello recognized Senator Edler for closing comments on [SSB 3105](#). Senator Edler provided closing comments and moved the bill.

[SSB 3105](#) passes 7-5 with Senators Mathis, Bolkcom, Jochum, Ragan, and Trone Garriott voting no.

[SSB 3105](#) moves to the calendar under Rule 40.

Senator Costello recognized Senator Edler for [SSB 3065](#).

Senator Edler provided the subcommittee report, gave a brief introduction and states there is an amendment.

Senator Costello recognized Senator Edler for opening comments on Amendment 3065.2959. Senator Edler provided opening comments on the amendment. Senator Costello opened the floor to discussion.

Senator Costello recognized Senator Jochum who made comments on the amendment.

Seeing none, Senator Costello recognized Senator Edler for closing comments on the amendment. Senator Edler moved the amendment.

Amendment 3065.2959 passes unanimously on a short form voice vote.

Senator Costello recognized Senator Edler for opening comments on [SSB 3065](#) as amended. Senator Edler had no further comments.

Senator Costello opened the floor to discussion.

Senator Costello recognized Senator Jochum who made comments.

Seeing no further discussion, Senator Costello recognized Senator Edler for closing comments on [SSB 3065](#). Senator Edler provided closing comments and moved the bill.

[SSB 3065](#) as amended passes 7-5 with Senators Mathis, Bolkcom, Jochum, Ragan, and Trone Garriott voting no. [SSB 3065](#) as amended moves to the calendar under Rule 40.

Senator Costello transferred the Chair back to Senator Edler.

Chairman Senator Edler provided comments. Senator Green motioned to adjourn.
