[SSB 3102](#) passed unanimously on a short form voice vote and moves to the calendar under Rule 40.

Senator Edler provided the subcommittee report and gave opening comments on the bill.

Senator Costello opened the floor to discussion.

Senator Costello recognized Senator Jochum who asked Senator Edler to yield.

Senator Edler agreed and Senator Jochum asked a question. Senator Edler responded.

Senator Jochum gave further comments.

Senator Costello recognized Senator Trone Garriott who made comments.

Senator Edler provided the subcommittee report, gave a brief introduction and states there is an amendment.

Senator Costello recognized Senator Jochum who made comments on the amendment.

Seeing none, Senator Costello recognized Senator Edler for closing comments on the amendment. Senator Edler moved the amendment.

Amendment 3065.2959 passes unanimously on a short form voice vote.

Senator Costello opened the floor to discussion.

Senator Costello recognized Senator Jochum who made comments.

[SSB 3065](#) as amended passes 7-5 with Senators Mathis, Bolkom, Jochum, Ragan, and Trone Garriott voting no. [SSB 3065](#) as amended moves to the calendar under Rule 40.
