Representative Jacoby asked Chairman Nordman for a Public Hearing on [HSB 626](#) and supplied the required documentation. Representative Hein made closing comments on [HSB 626](#) and moved the bill. Chairman Nordman moved the bill and the clerk called roll. [HSB 626](#) passes to the House floor as a committee bill with a vote of 14 yeas (Hein, Nordman, Bloomingdale, Graber, Hite, Jones, Kaufmann, Lohse, Maxwell, Mitchell, Osmundson, Sieck, Siegrist, Wheeler) and 10 nays (Jacoby, Gjerde, Isenhardt, James, Kurth, McConkey, Nielsen, Staed, Winckler, Wolfe) and 1 excused (Boden). Chairman Nordman transferred the gavel back to Rep. Hein. Chairman Hein announced with no other business to come before the committee, we would adjourn at 9:40 pm with Rep. Mascher motioning for adjournment.
