Chairwoman Ann Meyer recognized Representative Lundgren for opening remarks on [HF 2119](#): ***A bill for an act relating to the dispensing of abortion-inducing drugs to patients within the state, and providing penalties.***

Chairwomen Ann Meyer recognized Representative Lundgren for opening remarks on amendment 2119.2980. The amendment passed on short form. The bill as amended was moved and passed with a vote of 11 Ayes (Representatives Meyer, Bradley, Bacon, Bergan, Bush, Dolecheck, Fry, Jeneary, Lundgren, Moore, Osmundson), 8 Nays (Representatives Wessel-Kroeschell, Anderson, Bennett, Brown-Powers, Ehlert, Forbes, Mascher, Sunde), and 2 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

The bill as amended was moved and passed with a vote of 19 Ayes (Representatives Meyer, Bradley, Wessel-Kroeschell, Anderson, Bacon, Bennett, Bergan, Brown-Powers, Bush, Dolecheck, Ehlert, Forbes, Fry, Jeneary, Lundgren, Mascher, Moore, Osmundson, Sunde), 0 Nays and 2 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.

Chairwoman Ann Meyer recognized Representative Bacon for opening remarks on [HSB 638](#): ***A bill for an act related to health care employment agencies, and providing penalties.***

The bill moved and passed with a vote of 19 Ayes (Representatives Meyer, Bradley, Wessel-Kroeschell, Anderson, Bacon, Bennett, Bergan, Brown-Powers, Bush, Dolecheck, Ehlert, Forbes, Fry, Jeaneary, Lundgren, Mascher, Moore, Osmundson, Sunde), 0 Nays and 2 Absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Human Resources Committee bill.
