Chairman Bacon called the meeting to order at 4:35 pm. Roll call was read. All members were present. The minutes of the previous meeting were approved. Chairman Bacon read in [HSB 700](#) which had been previously electronically assigned. Chairman Bacon recognized Representative Gerhold for [HF 2069](#). Chairman Bacon recognized Representative Gerhold for Amendment [HF 2069.3009](#). At 4:40 pm the Democrats and Republicans went to caucus. The meeting was reconvened at 4:45 pm. Representative Gerhold was recognized for [HF 2069.3009](#). The amendment passed by voice vote. Representative Gerhold called for a vote for [HF 2069](#). The bill passed unanimously. [HF 2069](#), as amended, moved to the floor as a committee bill. Chairman Bacon recognized Representative Bradley for [HF 2103](#). Chairman Bacon opened up discussion on [HF 2103](#). Representative Bradley was recognized for amendment [HF 2103.3130](#). There was discussion. Amendment passed unanimously by voice vote. Representative Bradley was recognized for closing comments and moved the bill. The bill passed unanimously. [HF 2103](#), as amended, moved to the floor as a committee bill. Chairman Bacon pulled [HF 2214](#) from consideration. Chairman Bacon recognized Representative Baxter for [HSB 610](#). There was discussion. Representative Baxter moved [HSB 610](#). The clerk called the roll. There were 11 yeas (Representatives Bacon, Jeneary, Baxter, Bennett, Bradley, Fisher, Gerhold, Latham, McClintock, Mommsen, Thorup) and 9 nays (Representatives Brown-Powers, Bohannon, Cohoon, Hall, Judge, Maxwell, Mommsen, Smith, Thede) and 1 excused (Jacoby). [HSB 610](#) moved to the floor as a committee bill. Chairman Bacon recognized Representative Fisher for [HSB 700](#). Representative Fisher was recognized for amendment [HSB 700.3099](#). There was discussion. The amendment passed unanimously. There was discussion on the bill. Representative Fisher moved [HSB 700](#) as amended. The bill passed with 11 yeas (Representatives Bacon, Jeneary, Baxter, Bradley, Fisher, Gerhold, Latham, McClintock, Mommsen, Siegrist, Thorup) 8 nays (Representatives Brown-Powers, Bennett, Bohannon, Cohoon, Hall, Judge, Smith, Thede) and 2 excused (Jacoby, Maxwell). [HSB 700](#), as amended, moved to the floor as a committee bill. As there was no other business before the committee Representative Fisher moved to adjourn at 5:16 pm.
