Consideration of Bills

Rep Hein recognizes Rep Graber for opening comments on [HF 2291](#). Rep Graber stated the summary of the bill and brings amendment 3039 to the floor. Rep Staed stated his support for the amendment. Rep Graber made closing comments on the amendment and moved to vote on it. The amendment passed with a short-form vote. Rep Winckler had discussion on the bill as amended, and asked Rep Graber to yield for questions. Rep Graber agreed and the bill was further discussed. With no further discussion, Rep Graber made closing comments and moved the bill as amended.

[HF 2371](#) was brought to the committee for consideration. Rep Osmundson opened and made comments on the bill. Rep James was recognized for comments supporting the bill. Rep Osmundson made closing comments on the bill, and moved it be voted on. The committee unanimously voted to pass [HF 2371](#).

[HSB 615](#) was brought to the floor for consideration. Rep Maxwell opened with comments. Rep Hein opened the floor to comments. Rep Jacoby had discussion on the fiscal costs of the bill. With no further discussion, Rep Maxwell made closing

comments and moved that the bill be voted on. The committee unanimously voted to pass [HSB 615](#) out of Ways & Means.

[HSB 718](#) was brought to the committee for consideration. Rep Siegrist opened to discuss the bill. Rep Hein recognized Rep Winckler for discussion. Rep Winckler asked Rep Siegrist to yield for questions, and he did. Rep Isenhardt also asked Rep Siegrist to yield for questions, and he did. [HSB 718](#) was discussed, and some questions were clarified for the whole committee. With no further discussion, Rep Siegrist made closing comments and moved to vote on [HSB 718](#). The committee unanimously passed [HSB 718](#) from Ways & Means.
