[HF 2485](#) was withdrawn from the agenda.

A motion for a subcommittee of the whole to consider [HF 2496](#) was made by Senator Dawson. Motion passed on voice vote. Public comments were made on [HF 2496](#).

Motion to move [HF 2496](#) for consideration in full committee, and to dissolve subcommittee of the whole. Motion passed on voice vote. Senator Zaun reconvened the full committee and recognized Senator Dawson for [HF 2496](#). The bill passed unanimously on short form vote.

Senator Taylor was recognized for [HF 2372](#). Senator Taylor presented the subcommittee report. Discussion followed. The bill passed unanimously on short form vote.

Senator Schultz was recognized for [HF 2298](#). Senator Schultz presented the subcommittee report. Discussion followed. The bill passed on short form vote 10 yea 5 nay, with Senators Kinney, Bisignano, Bolkcom, Boulton, and Petersen voting nay. Senator Zaun turned the meeting over to Vice Chairman Garrett. Senator Zaun was recognized for [HF 2464](#). Senator Zaun presented the subcommittee report. Discussion followed. The bill passed unanimously on short form vote.

Senator Garrett turned the meeting back over to Senator Zaun. Senator Garrett was recognized for [HF 2481](#). Senator Garrett presented the subcommittee report. The bill passed on roll call vote 10 yea 5 nay, with Senators Kinney, Bisignano, Bolkcom, Boulton, and Petersen voting nay.

Senator Reichman was recognized for [HF 2472](#). Senator Reichman presented the subcommittee report. The bill passed unanimously on short form vote.
