Chairman Holt moved SF 513 to the floor with a unanimous vote of 17 ayes and 4 excused (Representatives Jacobsen, Prichard, Wessel-Kroeschell, and Wilburn). Chairman Holt recognized Representative Hite for opening comments on SF 2297. There was discussion. Rep. Hite moved SF 2297. Chairman Holt moved SF 2297 to the floor with a vote of 16 ayes (Representatives Holt, Gustafson, Anderson, Hansen, Hite, Jones, Kaufmann, Klein, Lohse, B.
