Chairman Holt called the Judiciary Committee meeting to order at 9:20 a.m.

Roll call was taken with 17 members present and four members excused (Representatives Jacobsen, Prichard, Wessel-Kroeschell, and Wilburn).

The previous meeting minutes were approved.

Chairman Holt announced the electronically assigned bill:

Chairman Holt recognized Representative Kaufmann for opening comments on [SF 513](#). There was discussion. Rep. Kaufmann moved [SF 513](#). Chairman Holt moved [SF 513](#) to the floor with a unanimous vote of 17 ayes and 4 excused (Representatives Jacobsen, Prichard, Wessel-Kroeschell, and Wilburn).

Chairman Holt recognized Representative Hite for opening comments on [SF 522](#). There was discussion. Rep. Hite moved [SF 522](#). Chairman Holt moved [SF 522](#) to the floor with a unanimous vote of 17 ayes and 4 excused (Representatives Jacobsen, Prichard, Wessel-Kroeschell, and Wilburn).

Chairman Holt recognized Representative Hite for opening comments on [SF 2297](#). There was discussion. Rep. Hite moved [SF 2297](#). Chairman Holt moved [SF 2297](#) to the floor with a vote of 16 ayes (Representatives Holt, Gustafson, Anderson, Hansen, Hite, Jones, Kaufmann, Klein, Lohse, B. Meyer, Mitchell, Olson, Osmundson, Salmon, Westrich, and Wheeler), 1 nay (Representative Wolfe), and 4 excused (Representatives Jacobsen, Prichard, Wessel-Kroeschell, and Wilburn).

Chairman Holt informed the Committee [SF 2328](#) was received from the Senate last Thursday. Being a complex, 10-Division bill that will require substantial vetting within a very short amount of time, Chairman Holt did not assign it.

Chairman Holt expressed his appreciation for the good, working relationship he has had with Ranking Member Wolfe and thanked her publicly for her hard work and commitment to open communication.

Ranking Member Wolfe offered remarks of her service on Judiciary Committee during her tenure in the Iowa House.
