Chairman Kaufmann announced the following bills for consideration: [SF 181](#), [HSB 80](#), and [HSB 60](#).

Chairman Kaufmann turned the Chair over to Vice Chair Kniff McCulla.

Chair Kniff McCulla recognized Representative Kaufmann for opening comments on [SF 181](#) and he indicated there was an amendment.

Chair Kniff McCulla recognized Representative Jacoby for opening comments on Amendment .210. There was discussion. With no further discussion Rep. Jacoby was recognized for closing comments on Amendment .210 and he moved the amendment requesting a division and a record. Amendment .210 failed on a roll call vote of 9 ayes (Representatives Jacoby, Croken, Forbes, Gjerde, Isenhardt, Judge, Kurth, Nielsen, and Wilson) and 16 nays (Representatives Kaufmann, Kniff McCulla, Best, Bloomingdale, Boden, Deyoe, Harris, Johnson, Jones, Lundgren, Osmundson, Sexton, Siegrist, Thompson, P., Wills, J., and Wulf).

There was discussion on [SF 181](#). Chair Kniff McCulla recognized Rep. Kaufmann for closing comments on [SF 181](#). Rep. Kaufmann moved the bill. Chair Kniff McCulla moved [SF 181](#) to the House floor on a roll call vote of 19 ayes (Representatives Kaufmann, Kniff McCulla, Best, Bloomingdale, Boden, Deyoe, Harris, Isenhardt, Johnson, Jones, Judge, Lundgren, Osmundson, Sexton, Siegrist, Thompson, P., Wills,

J., Wilson, and Wulf) and 6 nays (Representatives Jacoby, Croken, Forbes, Gjerde, Kurth, and Nielsen).

Chair Kniff McCulla recognized Rep. Kaufmann for opening comments on [HSB 80](#). There was discussion. Rep. Kaufmann was recognized for closing comments and he moved the bill. Chair Kniff McCulla moved [HSB 80](#) as a committee bill on a roll call vote of 24 ayes and 1 nay (Representative Gjerde).

Chair Kniff McCulla turned the Chair back over to Chairman Kaufmann.

Chairman Kauffman recognized Representative Lundgren for opening comments on [HSB 60](#). There was discussion. Rep. Lundgren was recognized for closing comments and she moved the bill. Chairman Kaufmann moved [HSB 60](#) as a committee bill on a roll call vote of 23 ayes and 2 nays (Representatives Nielsen and Wilson).
