 Vice Chair Senator Cournoyer recognized Senator Schultz for [SSB 1107](#).  
 Senator Schultz introduced the bill, provided the subcommittee report, and gave opening comments on the bill.  
 Vice Chair Senator Cournoyer opened the floor to discussion.  
 Seeing none, Vice Chair Senator Cournoyer recognized Senator Schultz for closing comments. Senator Schultz moved the bill.  
[SSB 1107](#) passed on a short form voice vote with Senators Boulton, Celsi, Jochum, and Weiner voting no. [SSB 1107](#) moves to the Calendar as a Committee Bill under Rule 40. Vice Chair Senator Cournoyer yielded the Chair back to Senator Schultz.  
 Senator Dawson motioned to adjourn.
