Chairwoman Bloomingdale recognized Rep. Golding for opening comments on Amendment .371. There was discussion. Rep. Golding moved the amendment short form. The amendment passed. Kaufmann, Lundgren, Matson, Sexton, Siegrist, Steckman, Wills, Wulf, Young) 6
nays (Representative Harris, Baeth, Cooling, Gjerde, Srinivas, Zabner). There was
discussion. With no further discussion, Rep. Bossman moved [HF 179](#) as amended.
Chairwoman Bloomingdale moved [HF 179](#) as amended on a roll call vote of 17 ayes
and 6 Nays (Representative Harris, Baeth, Cooling, Gjerde, Srinivas, Zabner). [HF 179](#)
as amended passes as a committee bill.

Chairwoman Bloomingdale recognized Representative Harris for opening comments
on [HSB 148](#). There was discussion. With no further discussion, Rep. Harris moved
[HSB 148](#). Chairwoman Bloomingdale moved [HSB 148](#) on a unanimous roll call vote
