[HF 67](#)-Chairman Kaufmann recognized Representative Jones for opening remarks on [HF 67](#). Representative Jones explained the bill and where it came from.

Representative Judge comments his approval of the bill. Representative Jones moves the bill to a vote. It passed unanimously, 25 ayes and 0 nays.

[HSB 66](#)- Representative Osmundson opens and explains the bill. With no discussion, Representative Osmundson moves the bill to a vote. It passed unanimously, 25 ayes and 0 nays.

[HSB 69](#)-Representative Kniff McCulla opens and explains the bill. There is an amendment. Amendment 404-Representative Kniff McCulla explains that it makes the bill retroactive. [HSB 69](#) as amended-Representative Isenhardt asks Representative Kniff McCulla to yield for a question. Representative Kniff McCulla clarified for Representative Isenhardt. With no further discussion, Representative Kniff McCulla moves to vote on the bill as amended. It passed unanimously, 25 ayes and 0 nays. Chairman Kaufmann recognizes Representative Wilson, who suggests [HF 264](#) be addressed and considered for future meeting. Chairman Kaufmann thanked her for the suggestion.
