Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Mohr for opening statements on [HSB 228](#). Representative Mohr gave closing remarks on [HSB 228](#) and moved the bill. With unanimous roll call vote of 23 ayes and 0 nays, [HSB 228](#) goes to the floor as a committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren turned Chair over to Representative Young. Chairman Young recognized Representative Lundgren for opening statements on [HSB 167](#), and there is an amendment 167.479(2). Chairman Young requested roll call vote on amendment 167.479(2). Roll call vote of 15 ayes (Representatives Lundgren, Young, Best, Bloomingdale, Deyoe, Graber, Kniff McCulla, Lohse, Mohr, G., Nordman, Thompson, P., Thomson, C., Vondran, Wills, J., Wilz, H.) 8 nays (Judge, Bagniewski, Forbes, Jacoby, Kressig, Nielsen, Scholten, Srinivas) Amendment 479(2) failed.

Representative Lundgren gave closing remarks on [HSB 167](#), and moved the bill. Roll call vote of 15 ayes (Representatives Lundgren, Young, Best, Bloomingdale, Deyoe, Graber, Kniff McCulla, Lohse, Mohr, G., Nordman, Thompson, P., Thomson, C., Vondran, Wills, J., Wilz, H.) 8 nays (Judge, Bagniewski, Forbes, Jacoby, Kressig, Nielsen, Scholten, Srinivas). [HSB 167](#) now goes to the floor as a committee bill.

Chairman Young, turned the Chair back over to Chairwoman Lundgren.

Chairman Lundgren recognized Representative Young for opening statements on [HSB 324](#). There is an amendment. Representative Young introduced amendment 324.556(2). Representative Young motioned to pass short form, amendment 324.556(2) passed. Representative Young gave closing remarks on [HSB 324](#), as amended and moved the bill. Chairwoman Lundgren moved [HSB 324](#) as amended to the floor with unanimous roll call vote of 23 ayes 0 nays. [HSB 324](#) as amended now moves to the floor as a committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Nordman for opening statements [HSB 175](#). There is an amendment. Representative Nordman introduced amendment 175.547(1). Representative Nordman motioned to pass short form, amendment 175.547(1) passed. Representative Nordman gave closing remarks on [HSB 175](#), as amended and moved the bill. Chairwoman Lundgren moved [HSB 175](#) as amended to the floor with unanimous roll call vote of 23 ayes 0 nays. [HSB 175](#) as amended now moves to the floor as a committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Wilz, J., for opening statements on [HSB 190](#). Representative Wilz gave closing remarks on [HSB 190](#) and moved the bill.

With unanimous roll call vote of 23 ayes and 0 nays, [HSB 190](#) now moves to the floor as a committee bill.
