Chairman Holt called the Judiciary Committee meeting to order at 10:12 a.m.

The amendment failed with 8 Ayes (Representatives Wilburn, Dunwell, James, Lohse, Meyer, B., Olson, Scheetz, and Wessel-Kroeschell), 11 Nays (Representatives Holt, Gustoff, Collins, Gustafson, Kaufmann, Nordman, Meyer, A., Stone, Thompson, P., Thomson, C., and Wheeler) and 2 Rule-76 (Representatives Jones and Srinivas).

Chair Gustoff recognized Representative Lohse for opening remarks on Amendment .648. There was discussion. Rep. Lohse moved Amendment .648 short form. Chair Gustoff declared the amendment failed.

Chair Gustoff recognized Representative Lohse for opening remarks on Amendment .668. There was discussion. Rep. Lohse moved Amendment .668 short form. Chair Gustoff declared the amendment failed.

Chair Gustoff recognized Representative Lohse for opening remarks on Amendment .675. There was discussion. Rep. Lohse offered closing remarks and moved Amendment .675 short form. Chair Gustoff declared the amendment failed. There was discussion on HF 368.

With no further discussion, Rep. Holt was recognized for closing remarks and moved HF 368. Chair Gustoff moved HF 368 as a committee bill on a roll call vote of 12 ayes (Representatives Holt, Gustoff, Collins, Gustafson, Kaufmann, Meyer, A., Nordman, Stone, Thompson, P., Thomson, C., Wessel-Kroeschell, and Wheeler), 7 nays (Representatives Wilburn, Dunwell, James, Lohse, Meyer, B., Olson and Scheetz), and 2 Rule-76 (Representatives Jones and Srinivas). Chair Gustoff turned the Chair back to Chairman Holt.
