Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Rep. Deyoe for opening statements on [HSB 134](#).

There is an amendment. Representative Deyoe introduced amendment 622.

Chairwomen Lundgren motioned roll call vote on amendment 622. Roll call vote of 15 ayes (Representatives Lundgren, Young, Best, Bloomingdale, Deyoe, Graber, Kniff McCulla, Lohse, Mohr, G., Nordman, Thompson, P., Thomson, C., Vondran, Wills, J., Wilz, H.) 8 Nays (Judge, Bagniewski, Forbes, Jacoby, Kressig, Nielsen, Scholten, Srinivas) amendment 622 passes.

Wilz, H.) 1 nay (Scholten) [HSB 192](#) now moves to floor as a committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Nordman for [HSB 174](#) for opening statements on [HSB 174](#). Representative Nordman gave closing remarks on [HSB 174](#), and moved the bill.
