Consideration of Bills:

Chairman Kaufmann recognized Rep. Devoe for HF 266. Rep Devoe introduced the bill. There is an amendment. Rep Devoe introduced and moved amendment 886 be voted on in short form. It passed. Back to the bill as amended, Rep Deyoe made closing comments and moved  $\underline{HF 266}$  to be voted on as amended. The clerk called the roll- with 24 ayes and 0 nays, the bill as amended passes as a committee bill. Chairman Kaufmann recognized Rep. Sexton for HF 277. Rep Sexton opens, and there are amendments. Chairman Kaufmann recognized Rep. Sexton for amendment 992. Rep Sexton explains the amendment and moves to a vote in short form. The amendment carries. Chairman Kaufmann recognized Rep Isenhart for amendment 1009. Rep Isenhart explains the amendment and opens the floor for discussion. There was discussion. Rep Isenhart moves the amendment and asks for a division and record. With a vote of 9 ayes (Reps Jacoby, Croken, Forbes, Gjerde, Isenhart, Judge, Kurth, Nielsen, and Wilson) and 15 nayes (Reps Kaufmann, Kniff McCulla, Best, Bloomingdale, Boden, Deyoe, Harris, Johnson, Jones, Lundgren, Osmundson, Sexton, Siegrist, Thompson, P. Wills, J. and Wulf) the amendment fails. Chairman Kaufmann recognized Rep. Sexton for amendment 990. Rep Sexton explained the amendment. There was discussion. Rep Sexton moved to vote in short form, and the amendment is adopted. Back on the bill as amended, there was discussion. Rep

Sexton closed on the bill and moved it to a vote. With 23 ayes and 1 nay, the bill as amended passes as a committee bill.

<u>HSB 68</u>-Chairman Kaufmann recognized Rep. Thompson for <u>HSB 68</u>. There are amendments. Amendment 1007-Chairman Kaufmann recognized Rep Gjerde. Rep Gjerde explains the amendment. There was discussion. Rep Gjerde closed and moved the amendment for a vote and requested a division and record. With a vote of 9 ayes (Reps Jacoby, Croken, Forbes, Gjerde, Isenhart, Judge, Kurth, Nielsen, and Wilson) and 15 nayes (Reps Kaufmann, Kniff McCulla, Best, Bloomingdale, Boden, Deyoe, Harris, Johnson, Jones, Lundgren, Osmundson, Sexton, Siegrist, Thompson, P. Wills, J. and Wulf) the amendment fails. Chairman Kaufmann recognized Rep Thompson for amendment 401. Rep Thompson explained and opened the floor for discussion. Rep Thompson moved the amendment to a vote in short form. The amendment carries. Back on <u>HSB 68</u> as amended there was discussion. Rep Thompson closed and moved the bill as amended be voted on. With 24 ayes and 0 nays, the bill as amended passed as a committee bill.

Chairman Kaufmann recognized Rep Johnson for opening comments on <u>HSB 124</u>. There was discussion. Rep Johnson made closing remarks and moved the bill to a vote. With 24 ayes and 0 nays, the bill passes as a committee bill. With no further business, Rep Jacoby moved to arise at 11:00 am.
