Chairwoman Ann Meyer called the meeting to order at 9:15 am.

Roll Call was read and a quorum was present.

As there were no corrections, amendments and/or deletions to the previous meeting minutes, they were unanimously approved.

Representative Fry was recognized for a motion.

Representative Fry moved that a time certain be set for the close of debate and that the Health and Human Services Committee act on the following question and all amendments file to the question that have been distributed to the committee members prior to the time certain taken effect, no later than 2:00 pm on Tuesday, July 11th, 2023, and then immediately proceed to closing remarks and final passage of House Study Bill 255.

A voice vote was taken and the motion passed.

The Health and Human Services Committee reconvened at 11:10 am.

Chairwoman Ann Meyer dissolved the meeting into subcommittee of the whole to consider [HSB 255](#).

As the Chair of the subcommittee for [HSB 255](#) Representative Lundgren was in order. Representative Lundgren made opening remarks and moved to vote on the Bill out of Subcommittee and asked for a Division and a Record.

[HSB 255](#) passed out of subcommittee with a vote of 14 Aye (Representatives Meyer, A., Wood, Andrews, Best, Boden, Bradley, Fry, Harris, Holt, Hora, Jeneary, Lundgren, Moore, T., and Wilz) 6 Nay (Representatives Wessel-Kroeschell, Baeth, Brown-Powers, Forbes, Madison, and Matson) and 1 absent.

Chairwoman Ann Meyer moved the meeting back to a full committee meeting.

The meeting stood at ease for both parties to go to caucus.

The meeting reconvened.

Chairwoman Ann Meyer recognized Representative Lundgren for opening remarks on [HSB 255](#).

Chairwoman Ann Meyer recognized Representative Wessel-Kroeschell for opening remarks on amendment 255.2259. Representative Wessel-Kroeschell moved the amendment and asked for a division and a record. The amendment failed with a vote of 6 Aye (Representatives Wessel-Kroeschell, Baeth, Brown-Powers, Forbes, Madison, and Matson) 14 Nay (Representatives Meyer, A., Wood, Andrews, Best,

Boden, Bradley, Fry, Harris, Holt, Hora, Jeneary, Lundgren, Moore, T., and Wilz), and 1 absent.

Chairwoman Ann Meyer recognized Representative Brown-Powers for opening remarks on amendment 255.2261. Representative Brown-Powers moved the amendment and asked for a division and a record. The amendment failed with a vote of 6 Aye (Representatives Wessel-Kroeschell, Baeth, Brown-Powers, Forbes, Madison, and Matson) 14 Nay (Representatives Meyer, A., Wood, Andrews, Best, Boden, Bradley, Fry, Harris, Holt, Hora, Jeneary, Lundgren, Moore, T., and Wilz), and 1 absent.

Chairwoman Ann Meyer recognized Representative Matson for opening remarks on amendment 255.2273. Representative Matson moved the amendment and asked for a division and a record. The amendment failed with a vote of 6 Aye (Representatives Wessel-Kroeschell, Baeth, Brown-Powers, Forbes, Madison, and Matson) 14 Nay (Representatives Meyer, A., Wood, Andrews, Best, Boden, Bradley, Fry, Harris, Holt, Hora, Jeneary, Lundgren, Moore, T., and Wilz), and 1 absent.

Chairwoman Ann Meyer recognized Representative Madison for opening remarks on amendment 255.2276. Representative Madison moved the amendment and asked for a division and a record. The amendment failed with a vote of 6 Aye (Representatives Wessel-Kroeschell, Baeth, Brown-Powers, Forbes, Madison, and Matson) 14 Nay (Representatives Meyer, A., Wood, Andrews, Best, Boden, Bradley, Fry, Harris, Holt, Hora, Jeneary, Lundgren, Moore, T., and Wilz), and 1 absent.

Chairwoman Ann Meyer recognized Representative Lundgren for closing comments on [HSB 255](#). The bill was moved and passed with a vote of 14 Aye (Representatives Meyer, A., Wood, Andrews, Best, Boden, Bradley, Fry, Harris, Holt, Hora, Jeneary, Lundgren, Moore, T., and Wilz) 6 Nay (Representatives Wessel-Kroeschell, Baeth, Brown-Powers, Forbes, Madison, and Matson) and 1 absent. The bill will move to the House Floor as a Health and Human Services Committee bill.
