Representative Vondran motioned to pass short form, amendment 473.2492(2) passed. Representative Vondran gave closing remarks on [HF 473](#), as amended and moved the bill. Chairwoman Lundgren moved [HF 473](#) as amended with unanimous roll call vote of 20 ayes 0 nays. [HF 473](#) as amended goes to the floor as a committee bill.
