Chairman Bossman provided an overview of the Transportation, Infrastructure, and Capitals Appropriations Subcommittee.

Chairperson Bossman introduced Maria Wagenhofer and Garry Martin from the Legislative Service Agency (LSA).

Questions were asked by RIIF Committee members (Chairman Bossman, Rep. Gehlbach, Rep. Rinker).

Questions were answered by Eick regarding specific programs, funding, markets, and investigations.

Chairman Bossman introduced Mark Willemssen, and Scott Allen to give an update on Capitol Maintenance.

Willemssen and Allen spoke about the maintenance plan, and the current maintenance taking place at the Capitol.

Questions were asked by RIIF Committee members (Rep. Gehlback, Rep. Rinker, Chairman Bossman).

Willemssen and Allen answered questions regarding timelines, the long-term maintenance plan.

Chairman Bossman motioned for adjournment, Rep. Judge seconded the motion, and the meeting adjourned at 11:59 am.
