Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Young for opening remarks on [HSB 606](#). Representative Young gave closing remarks on [HSB 606](#) and moved the bill. With unanimous roll call vote of 23 ayes and 0 nays, [HSB 606](#) now moves to the floor as a committee bill.

Chairwoman Lundgren recognized Representative Nordman for opening remarks on [HSB 609](#) and there is an amendment. Representative Nordman introduced amendment 2650(1) and moved the amendment short form. With unanimous consent [HSB 609](#) was amended.
