Chairman Sorensen recognized Rep. Latham for [HSB 622](#)

Representative Latham introduced [HSB 622](#) and gave her opening remarks. Rep.

Latham indicated there was an Amendment (Amendment 2642). Rep. Latham was recognized for opening comments on Amendment 2642. Rep. Latham was recognized for closing comments on Amendment 2642 and moved it short form. Amendment 2642 passed on a voice vote.

Rep. Isenhardt was recognized for question and comment. There was discussion.

Rep. Latham was recognized for closing comments on [HSB 622](#) as amended and moved the bill.

Chairman Sorensen called for a roll call vote on [HSB 622](#). With a vote of nineteen (19) ayes (Sorensen, Sieck, Staed, Buck, Carlson, Determann, Gaines, Gerhold, Graber, Ingels, Kniff McCulla, Latham, Madison, Moore, Osmundson, Scholten, Stoltenberg, Turek, Wood) and two (2) nays (Isenhardt, Wilson), the bill passes and moves on as a committee bill.

Representative Sorensen introduced [HF 2218](#) and gave his opening remarks.

Rep. Sieck called for a roll call vote on [HF 2218](#). With of a vote of twenty-two (21) ayes (Sorensen, Sieck, Staed, Buck, Carlson, Determann, Gaines, Gerhold, Graber, Ingels, Isenhardt, Kniff McCulla, Latham, Madison, Moore, Osmundson, Scholten, Stoltenberg, Turek, Wilson, Wood) and zero (0) nays, the bill passes and moves on as a committee bill.
