Senator Kraayenbrink recognized Senator J. Taylor for the subcommittee report and opening remarks on [SF 2260](#). Senator J. Taylor introduced Amendment 3775. Senator Kraayenbrink entertained comments from the floor. Senators Donahue and Dotzler were recognized for comment. Senator J. Taylor was recognized for closing comments and moved amendment 3775. Short form vote was requested. Amendment 3775 was approved with Senator Dotzler voting nay.

Back on [SF 2260](#) as amended. Senator Kraayenbrink entertained comments from the floor. Senators T. Taylor, Winckler, and Donahue were recognized for comment. Senator J. Taylor was recognized for closing comments and moved [SF 2260](#) as amended. Short form vote was requested. [SF 2260](#) as amended was approved with Senators Petersen, Celsi, Donahue, Dotzler, T. Taylor and Winckler voting nay. [SF 2260](#) as amended was moved to the Calendar as a committee bill.

Senator Kraayenbrink recognized Senator Green for the subcommittee report and opening remarks on [SF 2327](#). Senator Green introduced Amendment 3705. Senator Kraayenbrink entertained comments from the floor. Senator T. Taylor was recognized for comment. Senator Green moved amendment 3705. Short form vote was requested. Amendment 3705 was unanimously approved.

Back on [SF 2327](#) as amended. Senator Kraayenbrink entertained comments from the floor. With no discussion, Senator Green was recognized for closing comments and moved [SF 2327](#) as amended. Short form vote was requested. [SF 2327](#) as amended was unanimously approved and moved to the Calendar as a committee bill.

Senator Kraayenbrink recognized Senator Edler for the subcommittee report and opening remarks on [SSB 3188](#). Senator Edler introduced Amendment 3757. Senator Kraayenbrink entertained comments from the floor. Senator Dotzler was recognized for comment. Senator Edler moved amendment 3757. A record vote was requested. Amendment 3757 was approved with 13 yeas; 7 nays (Petersen, Celsi, Donahue, Dotzler, Giddens, T. Taylor, Winckler)

Back on [SSB 3188](#) as amended. Senator Kraayenbrink entertained comments from the floor. Senators Dotzler, Donahue, and Celsi were recognized for comment. Senator Edler was recognized for closing comments and moved [SSB 3188](#) as amended. A record vote was requested. [SSB 3188](#) as amended was approved with 11 yeas; 9 nays (Petersen, Alons, Celsi, Donahue, Dotzler, Giddens, Lofgren, T. Taylor, Winckler) [SSB 3188](#) as amended moved to the Calendar as a committee bill.

Senator Kraayenbrink turned the chair over to Vice-Chair Zumbach. Senator Zumbach recognized Senator Kraayenbrink for the subcommittee report and opening

remarks on [SF 2133](#). Senator Kraayenbrink introduced Amendment 3769. Senator Zumbach entertained comments from the floor. Senator Dotzler was recognized for comment. With no further discussion, Senator Kraayenbrink moved Amendment 3769. Short form vote was requested. Amendment 3769 was approved with 14 yeas; 6 nays (Petersen, Celsi, Donahue, Dotzler, T. Taylor, Winckler)
Back on [SF 2133](#) as amended. Senator Zumbach entertained comments from the floor. Senator Dotzler was recognized for comment. Senator Zumbach recognized Senator Kraayenbrink for closing comments on [SF 2133](#) as amended. Senator Kraayenbrink simply moved the bill. Short form vote was requested. [SF 2133](#) as amended was unanimously approved and moved to the Calendar as a committee bill.
Vice-Chair Zumbach turned the meeting back over to Senator Kraayenbrink.
