A short form vote was requested. [SSB 3202](#) passed with 18 yeas; 1 nay (Petersen); 1 excused and moved to the Calendar as a committee bill.

Senator Costello moved the bill. A short form vote was requested. [SSB 3205](#) passed with 12 yeas; 7 nays (Petersen, Celsi, Donahue, Dotzler, Giddens, T. A short form vote was requested. [HF 2663](#) was unanimously approved and moved to the Calendar.
