Roll call was taken. A quorum was present.

With no further discussion Representative Meggers made closing remarks and moved to vote. Chairman Vondran moved [HF 41](#) as a committee bill with a passing unanimous roll call vote of 23 Yeas and 0 Nays.

Chairman Vondran recognized Representative Meggers for opening remarks on [HF 45](#). There was discussion. Representative Meggers made closing remarks and moved to vote. Chairman Vondran moved [HF 45](#) as a committee bill with a passing roll call vote of 21 Yeas (Representatives Vondran, Wengryn, Gjerde, Amos Jr., Brown-Powers, Dieken, Fisher, Gearhart, Gosa, Gustoff, Henderson, Hermanson, Holt, Kressig, Levin, Meggers, Meyer, Mohr, Rinker, Wessel-Kroeschell, and Wills), and 2 Nays (Representatives Cisneros and Thomson).

Chairman Vondran recognized Representative Rinker for opening remarks on [HF 55](#). A brief introduction of the bill was given. Chairman Vondran Recognized Representative Rinker for opening remarks of Amendment 55.15 to [HF 55](#). Closing remarks were made by Representative Rinker and a short form vote was requested. The Ayes appear to have it and the amendment passed. Representative Rinker moved to vote on the newly amended [HF 55](#). Chairman Vondran moved the amended [HF 55](#) as a committee bill with a passing roll call vote of 21 Yeas (Representatives Vondran, Wengryn, Gjerde, Amos Jr., Brown-Powers, Cisneros, Dieken, Fisher, Gearhart, Gosa, Gustoff, Henderson, Hermanson, Holt, Kressig, Meggers, Meyer, Mohr, Rinker, Thomson, and Wills), and 2 Nays (Representatives Levin and Wessel-Kroeschell).

Chairman Vondran recognized Representative Dieken for opening remarks on [HSB 22](#). There was discussion. With no further discussion Representative Dieken moved to vote. Chairman Vondran moved [HSB 22](#) as a committee bill with a passing roll call vote of 20 Yeas (Representatives Vondran, Wengryn, Gjerde, Brown-Powers, Cisneros, Dieken, Fisher, Gearhart, Gosa, Gustoff, Henderson, Hermanson, Holt, Kressig, Meggers, Meyer, Mohr, Rinker, Thomson, and Wills), and 3 Nays (Amos Jr., Levin, and Wessel-Kroeschell).

Chairman Vondran recognized Representative Dieken for opening remarks on [HSB 25](#). There was a discussion. Representative Dieken moved to vote on the bill. Chairman Vondran moved [HSB 25](#) as a committee bill with a passing unanimous roll call vote of 23 Yeas and 0 Nays.

Chairman Vondran recognized Representative Wills for opening remarks on [HSB 24](#). There was a discussion. Chairman Vondran recognized Representative Wills for opening remarks on Amendment 24.43. With no further discussion a roll call vote took place, passing Amendment 24.43 with 23 Ayes (Vondran, Wengryn, Gjerde, Amos, Brown-Powers, Cisneros, Dieken, Fisher, Gearhart, Gosa, Gustoff, Henderson, Hermanson, Holt, Kressig, Levin, Meggers, Meyer, Mohr, Rinker, Thomson, Wessel-Kroeschell, Wills) and 0 Nays. A discussion was held for [HSB 24](#). With no further questions Representative Wills moved to vote on [HSB 24](#). Chairman Vondran moved [HSB 24](#) as a committee bill with a passing roll call vote of 21 Yeas (Representatives Vondran, Wengryn, Gjerde, Amos Jr., Brown-Powers, Cisneros, Dieken, Fisher, Gearhart, Gosa, Gustoff, Henderson, Hermanson, Holt, Kressig, Meggers, Meyer,

Mohr, Rinker, Thomson, and Wills), and 2 Nays (Levin, and Wessel-Kroschell).

Chairman Vondran recognized Representative Dieken for opening remarks on [HSB 29](#). A discussion was held. Closing remarks were made by Representative Dieken. Chairman Vondran moved [HSB 29](#) as a committee bill with a passing unanimous roll call vote of 23 Yeas and 0 Nays.

With no other business to come before the committee, Chairman Vondran made closing remarks.
