Senator Evans then recognized Senator Gruenhagen for [SSB 1022](#). Subcommittee report was turned in. Opening remarks were made. There was no discussion and closing comments were made. The bill was moved and passed by a short form vote and moved to calendar under rule 40.

Senator Evans next recognized Senator Taylor for [SSB 1023](#). Subcommittee report was turned in. He gave opening remarks on Amendment #1023.101. The amendment moved and passed short form. He then went back to bill and gave opening remarks. A short form vote was taken and the amendment passed and moved to calendar under rule 40.

Senator Evans again recognized Senator Taylor for [SSB 1028](#). Subcommittee report was turned in.

Opening remarks were made for Amendment #1028.39. There was discussion on amendment. Short form vote was taken and passed. Opening remarks were made on the bill and there was discussion. Closing comments were made and a roll call vote was called for and the bill passed by a 11-5 vote, with Senators Quirnbach, Winckler, Donahue, Trone-Garriott, and Staed voting no. The bill was passed to the calendar under rule 40

Senator Evans yielded the chair to Senator Taylor and was recognized for [SF 16](#). Subcommittee report turned in. Senator Evans gave opening remarks. There was no discussion. Closing comments were made
Short form vote all voting yes. .
