Stone moved the bill, as amended. Chairman Holt moved [HF 64](#), as amended as a committee bill on a roll call vote of 16 ayes (Representatives Holt, Lawler, James, Dunwell, Fett, Gustoff, Lohse, Nordman, Olson, Shipley, Stone, M. Thompson, C. Thomson, Wheeler, Williams, and Wills), 4 nays (Representatives Croken, Srinivas, Wessel-Kroeschell, and Wilburn) and 1 excused (Representative B. Meyer).

Thompson, Wessel-Kroeschell, Wheeler, Wilburn, Williams, and Wills), 1 nay (Representative C. Thomson), and 1 excused (Representative B. Meyer).

Chairman Holt recognized Representative Williams for opening comments on [HSB 39](#) and he indicated there was Amendment 39.68. Rep. Williams was recognized for opening comments on the amendment. There was discussion. With no further discussion, Rep. Williams moved the amendment short form and it passed. With no further discussion, Rep. Williams moved the bill, as amended. Chairman Holt moved [HSB 39](#), as amended as a committee bill on a unanimous roll call vote of 20 ayes, 0 nays, and 1 excused (Representative B. Meyer).

Chairman Holt recognized Representative Lohse for opening comments on [HSB 41](#). There was discussion. With no further discussion, Rep. Lohse moved the bill. Chairman Holt moved [HSB 41](#) as a committee bill on a roll call vote of 14 ayes (Representatives Holt, Lawler, Dunwell, Fett, Gustoff, Lohse, Nordman, Shipley, Stone, M. Thompson, C. Thomson, Wheeler, Williams, and Wills) and 6 nays (Representatives James, Croken, Olson, Srinivas, Wessel-Kroeschell, and Wilburn), and 1 excused (Representative B. Meyer).
