Senator Evans called the Education meeting to order at 11:25. Roll call was taken silently and the minutes were approved as distributed. Senator reported that subcommittee assignments will be coming and that [SSB 1026](#) would be taken off the list of bills to be considered today.

Senator Evans then turned the chair over to Senator Taylor who recognized Senator Evans for [SSB 1025](#). He turned in his subcommittee report signed by Senators Evans and Green. Senator Trone-Garriot did not sign the report. Opening comments were made and there was an amendment. Opening comments were given on the amendment. There was discussion and then closing comments were made. Short form vote was requested and the amendment was adopted. Back to the bill as amended and there was discussion. Closing comments were made and short form vote requested and passed 11-5, with Senators Donahue, Staed, Quirnbach, Winckler and Trone-Garriot voting no. The bill, as amended, passed to the Calendar under Rule 40.

Senator Taylor then recognized Senator Evans for [SSB 1027](#). The subcommittee report was turned in and signed by Senators Evans, Campbell & Winckler. Opening comments were made and there was discussion. Closing comments were given and a short form vote was requested and passed unanimously. Passed to the Calendar under Rule 40.

Senator Taylor turned the chair back to Senator Evans who recognized Senator Shipley for [SSB 1036](#). Senators Shipley, Gruenhagen, and Trone-Garriot all signed off on the subcommittee report. Opening comments were made and there was a short discussion. Senator Shipley moved the bill and short vote form was requested and passed unanimously. The bill passed to the Calendar under Rule 40.
