Senator Evans recognized Senator Gruenhagen for [SF 127](#). Senator Gruenhagen submitted his subcommittee report with himself & Senator Taylor signing and Senator Quirnbach declining. Opening comments were given by Senator Gruenhagen. There was discussion. Closing remarks were made & he moved the bill. Short form vote was requested and passed 11-5, with Senators Quirnbach, Donahue, Winckler, Trone-Garriott, and Zimmer voting no. The bill moved to the Calendar as a Committee bill.

Senator Evans recognized Senator Salmon for [SF 138](#). Subcommittee report was turned in with Senators Salmon & Campbell signing and Senator Trone-Garriott declining. Opening remarks were made by Senator Salmon. There was no discussion. Closing comments were given & she moved the bill. Short form vote was requested and passed 11-5, with Senators Quirnbach, Donahue, Winckler, Trone-Garriott, and Zimmer voting no. The bill was moved to the Calendar as a Committee bill.

There was an amendment #172.435. Opening comments were given & there was no discussion. Short form vote passed. Back to the bill, as amended. There was discussion. Closing remarks were given and he moved the bill. Short form vote passed. The bill was moved to the Calendar as an individual bill.

Senator Evans recognized Senator Taylor for [SF 237](#). Senators Taylor, Campbell, and Winckler all signed the subcommittee report. Opening comments were made by Senator Taylor.
