Scheetz for opening comments on amendment 173.690. There was discussion. With no further discussion Rep. Scheetz moved the amendment and requested a division and record roll call. Chairwoman Bloomingdale moved the amendment on a roll call vote of 6 ayes (Representatives Nielsen, Cooling, Scheetz, Srinivas, Turek, Zabner), 15 nays (Representatives Bloomingdale, Smith, Bergan, Bossman, Collins, Dunwell, Harris,

Hora, Jeneary, Johnson, Jones, Kaufmann, Lundgren, Wilz, Wulf), and 2 excused (Representatives Siegrist, Wilburn). The amendment failed. There was discussion on [HSB 173](#) as amended. With no further discussion, Rep. Wulf moved [HSB 173](#) as amended. Chairwoman Bloomingdale moved [HSB 173](#) as amended on a roll call vote of 15 ayes (Representatives Bloomingdale, Smith, Bergan, Bossman, Collins, Dunwell, Harris, Hora, Jeneary, Johnson, Jones, Kaufmann, Lundgren, Wilz, Wulf), 6 nays (Representatives Nielsen, Cooling, Scheetz, Srinivas, Turek, Zabner), and 2 excused (Representatives Siegrist, Wilburn). [HSB 173](#) as amended passed and moves to the floor as a committee bill.
