### Consideration of Bills:

Chairman Kaufmann recognized Rep. Boden for [HSB 321](#). Rep. Boden made opening comments, and there was discussion. With no further discussion, Rep. Boden made closing comments and moved the bill to a vote. with 15 ayes (Reps. Kaufmann, Behn, Bloomingdale, Boden, Holt, Johnson, Jones, Lundgren, Meggers, Nordman, Wichtendahl, Wills, Wilson, Wulf, and Young) 7 nays (Reps. Hermanson, Jacoby, Baeth, Gjerde, Judge, McBurney, and Vondran) and 3 excused (Reps. James, Sexton, Siegrist) the bill passed out of committee.

Chairman Kaufmann recognized Rep. Young for [HF 617](#). Rep. Young made opening comments on the bill, and there was an amendment. Chairman Kaufmann recognized Rep. Young for amendment .1312. Rep. Young made opening comments on the amendment, and there was discussion. With no further discussion, Rep. Young moved to vote on the amendment in short form. The amendment carried. With no further discussion on the bill, Rep. Young made closing comments and moved the bill as amended to a vote. With 22 ayes, 0 nays, and 3 excused (Reps. Holt, Siegrist, Sexton) the bill as amended unanimously passed out of committee.

Chairman Kaufmann recognized Rep. Nordman for [HSB 226](#). Rep. Nordman made opening comments on the bill, and there was discussion. With no further discussion, Rep. Nordman moved the bill to a vote. With 20 ayes (Reps. Kaufmann, Hermanson, Baeth, Behn, Bloomingdale, Boden, James, Johnson, Jones, Judge, Lundgren, McBurney, Meggers, Nordman, Vondran, Wichtendahl, Wills, Wilson, Wulf, and Young) 2 nays (Reps. Jacoby and Gjerde) and 3 excused (Reps. Holt, Sexton, and Siegrist) the bill passed out of committee.

Chairman Kaufmann recognized Rep. Young for [HF 132](#). Rep. Young made opening comments, and there was discussion. With no further discussion, Rep. Young moved the to a vote. with 22 ayes, 0 nays, and 3 excused (Reps. Holt, Siegrist, and Sexton) the bill unanimously passed out of committee.

With no further business, Rep. Jacoby moved to arise, and Chairman Kaufmann adjourned the meeting at 10:35 am.
