Chairman Kaufmann called the Ways and Means committee meeting to order at 4:10 PM.

The clerk took roll call and a quorum was present with Reps. Jacoby, James, Sexton, Siegrist, Wichtendahl, and Wulf excused.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved unanimously.

Chairman Kaufmann moved to convene the subcommittee of the whole for [HF 1014](#). The motion was unanimous, and the committee moved into a subcommittee of the whole.

Rep. Lundgren gave opening comments on [HF 1014](#). There was discussion from the public. Rep. Lundgren gave closing comments. Rep. Lundgren moved [HF 1014](#) and the bill passed the subcommittee via a voice vote.

Chairman Kaufmann moved to dissolve the subcommittee of the whole for [HF 1014](#). The motion was unanimous and the subcommittee of the whole moved back into a committee.

Both parties went to caucus at 4:15 PM.

Upon conclusion of the caucuses at 5:05 PM, the clerk took roll call, and a quorum was present with Reps. Jacoby, James, Sexton, Siegrist, Wichtendahl, and Wulf excused.

Chairman Kaufmann recognized Rep. Lundgren for opening remarks on [HF 1014](#). Rep. Lundgren gave opening remarks. There were amendments. Chairman Kaufmann recognized Rep. Lundgren for opening remarks on amendment .1628. There was discussion. Rep. Lundgren moved the amendment. Amendment .1628 passed short form. Chairman Kaufmann recognized Rep. Lundgren for opening remarks on amendment .1784. There was no discussion. Rep. Lundgren moved the amendment. Amendment .1784 passed short form. There was no discussion on the bill as amended. Rep. Lundgren was recognized for closing remarks. Rep. Lundgren gave closing remarks and moved [HF 1014](#) as amended. [HF 1014](#) as amended was passed 19 yeas, 0 nays, and 6 excused (Reps. Jacoby, James, Sexton, Siegrist, Wichtendahl, Wulf).

Chairman Kaufmann recognized Rep. Nordman for opening remarks on [SF 469](#). Rep. Nordman gave opening remarks. There were amendments. Chairman Kaufmann recognized Rep. Baeth for opening remarks on amendment .1745. There was discussion. Rep. Baeth moved the amendment. Amendment .1745 failed on a roll call vote of 5 yeas (Reps. Baeth, Gjerde, Judge, McBurney, Wilson), 14 nays (Reps. Kaufmann, Hermanson, Behn, Bloomingdale, Boden, Holt, Johnson, Jones, Lundgren, Meggers, Nordman, Vondran, Wills, Young), and 6 excused (Reps. Jacoby, James, Sexton, Siegrist, Wichtendahl, Wulf). There was discussion. Rep. Nordman was recognized for closing remarks. Rep. Nordman gave closing remarks and moved [SF 469](#). [SF 469](#) was passed 14 yeas (Reps. Kaufmann, Hermanson, Behn, Bloomingdale, Boden, Holt, Johnson, Jones, Lundgren, Meggers, Nordman, Vondran, Wills, Young), 5 nays (Reps. Baeth, Gjerde, Judge, McBurney, Wilson), and 6 excused (Reps. Jacoby, James, Sexton, Siegrist, Wichtendahl, Wulf).

With no further business, Rep. McBurney moved to arise, and the meeting arised at 5:25 PM.
