The Appropriations meeting was called to order.

Chairman Kraayenbrink moved the Appropriations Committee dissolve into a subcommittee of the whole for [SSB 1240](#) and [SSB 1241](#). Motion carried without objection.

Subcommittee was held on [SSB 1240](#). Following discussion, Chair moved [SSB 1240](#) to the full committee recommending passage and amendment. Motion carried 22-0 without objection.

Subcommittee was held on [SSB 1241](#). Following discussion, Chair moved [SSB 1241](#) to the full committee recommending passage. Motion carried 15-7 on a party-line vote.

Chair moved to dissolve the subcommittee of the whole. Motion carried without objection.

Chair called back to order the Appropriations Committee and announced the following bills would be taken up: [SSB 1240](#) and [SSB 1241](#).

Senator Kraayenbrink turned the chair over to Senator Zumbach. Sen. Zumbach recognized Sen. Kraayenbrink for opening remarks on [SSB 1240](#). Senator Zumbach recognized Sen. Kraayenbrink for amendment [SSB 1240.2067](#). Following discussion, Sen. Kraayenbrink moved amendment 2067. Amendment 2067 was adopted on a short form vote of 22-0. Following further discussion, Sen. Kraayenbrink was recognized for closing remarks and moved [SSB 1240](#). A short form vote was requested. [SSB 1240](#) as amended passed 22-0.

Sen. Zumbach recognized Sen. Kraayenbrink for opening remarks on [SSB 1241](#). Following discussion, Sen. Kraayenbrink was recognized for closing remarks and moved [SSB 1241](#). A record vote was requested. [SSB 1241](#) passed 15-7 on a party-line vote.
