Senator Bousset was recognized for [SSB 3019](#). He presented a subcommittee report. Discussion followed. [SSB 3019](#) passed on a short form vote.

Senator Taylor was recognized for [HF 571](#). Senator Taylor presented a subcommittee report. Discussion followed. [HF 571](#) passed 12-6 on a roll call vote, with Senators Bisignano, Blake, Quirnbach, Weiner, Knox, and Peterson voting no.
