Representative Vondran turned the chair over to Representative Wengryn. Chairman Wengryn recognized Representative Vondran for opening remarks on [HSB 641](#). An introduction to the bill was given. Chairman Wengryn recognized Representative Gosa for Amendment 641.2512 to [HSB 641](#). A discussion was held. A division of record was requested. Amendment 641.2512 failed to pass with a roll call vote of 9 Ayes (Representatives Gjerde, Amos Jr., Brown-Powers, Cisneros, Gosa, Kressig, Kurth, Levin, Wessel-Kroeschell) and 14 Nays (Representatives Vondran, Wengryn, Dieken, Fisher, Gearhart, Gustoff, Henderson, Hermanson, Holt, Meggers, Mohr, Rinker, Thomson, Wills.). Chairman Wengryn recognized Representative Vondran for opening remarks on amendment 641.2446 to [HSB 641](#). Closing remarks were made by Representative Vondran and a short form vote was requested. The Ayes appear to have it and the amendment passes. Representative Vondran made closing remarks for [HSB 641](#) as amended and a motion to vote was made. Chairman Wengryn moved [HSB 641](#) as an amended committee bill with a passing roll call vote of 15 Ayes (Representatives Vondran, Wengryn, Cisneros, Dieken, Fisher, Gearhart, Gustoff, Henderson, Hermanson, Holt, Meggers, Mohr, G., Rinker, Thomson, C., Wills, J.) and 8 Nays (Representatives Gjerde, Amos Jr., Brown-Powers, Gosa, Kressig, Kurth, Levin, Wessel-Kroeschell).

Representative Wengryn turned the chair back over to Representative Vondran.

Chairman Vondran moved [HSB 651](#) as a committee bill with a passing roll call vote of 15 Ayes (Representatives Vondran, Wengryn, Dieken, Fisher, Gearhart, Gosa, Gustoff, Henderson, Hermanson, Holt, Meggers, Mohr, G., Rinker, Thomson, C., Wills, J.) and 8 Nays (Representatives Gjerde, Amos Jr., Brown-Powers, Cisneros, Kressig, Kurth, Levin, Wessel-Kroeschell).

Chairman Vondran recognized Representative Wills, J. for opening remarks on [HF 2158](#). An introduction to the bill was given. Chairman Vondran recognized Representative Wills, J. for opening remarks on amendment 2158.2486. A discussion was held and a request for a short form vote was made. The Ayes appear to have it and the amendment passes. Representative Wills, J. made closing remarks on [HF 2158](#) as amended and a motion to vote was made. Chairman Vondran moved [HF 2158](#) as an amended committee bill with a passing roll call vote of 22 Ayes (Representatives Vondran, Wengryn, Gjerde, Brown-Powers, Cisneros, Dieken, Fisher, Gearhart, Gosa, Gustoff, Henderson, Hermanson, Holt, Kressig, Kurth, Levin, Meggers, Mohr, G., Rinker, Thomson, C., Wessel-Kroeschell, Wills, J.) and 1 Nay (Representative Amos Jr.)
