Senator Warme recognized Senator Webster for subcommittee report and opening remarks on [SSB 3140](#). Senator Warme recognized Senator Webster for amendment [SSB 3140.2777](#). Amendment passed on a voice vote 11-6 with Senators Trone Garriott, Zimmer, Donahue, Petersen, Drey, and Hardman being recorded as a No vote. Back on the bill as amended. Senator Webster moved [SSB 3140](#) as amended and asked for support. The bill was approved on a voice vote 11-6 with Senators Trone Garriott, Zimmer, Donahue, Petersen, Drey, and Hardman being recorded as a No vote. [SSB 3140](#) as amended moves to the Calendar as a committee bill.

Senator Warme turned the chair over to Senator Costello.

Senator Costello recognized Senator Warme for subcommittee report and opening remarks on [SSB 3145](#). Following debate, Senator Warme moved [SSB 3145](#) and asked for support. A record roll call vote was taken. Senator Sweeney raised a point of order, and the Chair recognized her point. The Committee stood at ease at 12:55pm. The Chair called back to order the committee at 1pm and announced that [SSB 3145](#) failed to pass on a roll call vote 9-8 with Senators Warme, Costello, Evans, Guth, Salmon, Sweeney, Zumbach, Hardman, and Zimmer voting Yes and Senators Trone Garriott, Alons, Donahue, Lofgren, Webster, Pike, Drey, and Petersen voting No, and Senator Rowley Excused. Senator Costello recognized Senator Warme for subcommittee report and opening remarks on [SSB 3084](#). Senator Costello recognized Senator Warme for amendment [SSB 3084.2763](#). Amendment passed unanimously on a voice vote. Back on the bill as amended. Following debate, Senator Warme moved [SSB 3084](#) as amended and asked for support. The bill was approved on a voice vote 17-0. [SSB 3084](#) as amended moves to the Calendar as a committee bill.

Senator Costello recognized Senator Warme for subcommittee report and opening remarks on [SSB 3118](#). Senator Costello recognized Senator Warme for amendment [SSB 3118.2772](#). Amendment passed unanimously on a voice vote. Back on the bill as amended. Following debate, Senator Warme moved [SSB 3118](#) as amended and asked for support. The bill was approved on a voice vote 17-0. [SSB 3118](#) as amended moves to the Calendar as a committee bill.

Senator Costello recognized Senator Warme for subcommittee report and opening remarks on [SSB 3111](#). Senator Costello recognized Senator Warme for amendment [SSB 3111.2768](#). Amendment passed on a voice vote 14-3 with Senators Trone Garriott, Zimmer, and Donahue being recorded as a No vote. Back on the bill as amended. Following debate, Senator Warme moved [SSB 3111](#) as amended and asked for support. The bill was approved on a voice vote 10-7 with Senators Trone Garriott, Alons, Hardman, Zimmer, Drey, Donahue, and Petersen being recorded as a No vote. [SSB 3111](#) as amended moves to the Calendar as a committee bill.

Senator Costello turned the chair back over to Senator Warme.

Senator Warme brought up [SF 2315](#) under any other bills available for consideration.

Senator Warme recognized Senator Guth for subcommittee report and opening remarks on [SF 2315](#). Following debate, Senator Guth moved [SF 2315](#) and asked for support. The bill was approved on a roll call vote 17-0-1 with Senator Rowley excused. [SF 2315](#) moves to the Calendar as an individual bill.

Senator Pike moved to adjourn. Motion carried without objection.
