The meeting was called to order at 4:50 p.m. by Chairman Dawson. A silent roll call was taken with Senator Rowley and Senator Boussetol being excused. The minutes from the previous meeting were approved and the subcommittee and governor appointment assignments were distributed electronically. The following governor appointments were brought before the committee:

Chairman Dawson made a motion for the governor appointments to be placed on the en bloc calendar. Vice Chairman Gruenhagen approved the motion and the appointments were moved to the en bloc for their confirmation by the full Iowa Senate. Chairman Dawson yielded the chair to Vice Chairman Gruenhagen. Senator Dawson was recognized for [SSB 3001](#) and amendment .3366. The amendment was introduced and discussed. Senator Bisignano requested a short form vote on the amendment, which passed unanimously. The bill as amended was discussed and a short form vote was requested. The bill passed with 15 yeas and with Senator Quirnbach voting “present”. Vice Chairman Gruenhagen yielded the chair back to Chairman Dawson. Chairman Dawson recognized Senator Green for [SF 2464](#). The bill was discussed and a roll call vote was requested. The bill passed with 10 yeas and six nays. Those voting "nay" were Senators Bisignano, Dotzler, Petersen, Quirnbach, Townsend, and Winckler. Senator Taylor was recognized for [SF 2363](#). The bill was discussed and a short form vote was requested. The bill passed unanimously. Chairman Dawson recognized Senator Green for [SF 2140](#). The bill was discussed and a short form vote was requested. The bill passed unanimously. Chairman Dawson yielded the chair to Vice Chairman Gruenhagen. Senator Dawson was recognized for [SF 2085](#) and amendment .3348. The amendment was introduced and discussed. Senator Bisignano requested a short form vote on the amendment, which passed unanimously. The bill as amended was discussed and a short form vote passed unanimously. Chairman Vice Chairman Gruenhagen yielded the chair back to Chairman Dawson. Senator Dawson recognized Senator Sweeney for [SF 2317](#). The bill was discussed and a short form vote was requested. The bill passed unanimously. With no additional business being brought before the meeting, Senator Koelker moved to adjourn at 5:25 p.m.
