Senator Reichman was recognized for [HF 2695](#). He presented a subcommittee report and gave opening comments.

There was no discussion on the bill. Senator Reichman moved the bill. [HF 2695](#) passed on a short form vote, 18-0.

Senator Schultz turned the Chair over to Senator Taylor.

Senator Schultz was recognized for [HF 2711](#). He presented a subcommittee report and gave opening comments.

Senator Schultz was recognized for amendment 2711.3546. He gave opening comments and there was discussion.

The amendment passed on a short form vote, 18-0. Back to the bill, as amended. There was discussion. Senator Schultz moved the bill as amended. [HF 2711](#) passed on a short form vote, 12-6, with Senators Blake, Knox, Petersen, Quirnbach, Weiner, and Bisignano voting no.

Senator Taylor turned the Chair back to Senator Schultz.

Senator Bousset was recognized for [HF 2542](#). He presented a subcommittee report and gave opening comments.

Senator Bousset was recognized for amendment 2542.3484 and gave opening comments. The amendment passed on a short form vote, 18-0. Back to the bill, as amended, and there was discussion. Senator Bousset gave closing comments and moved the bill, as amended. [HF 2542](#) passed on a roll call vote, 12-6, with Senators Blake, Quirnbach, Bisignano, Petersen, Weiner, and Knox voting no.

Senator Bousset was recognized for [HF 2696](#). He presented a subcommittee report and gave opening comments.

There was discussion on the bill. Senator Bousset gave closing comments and moved the bill. [HF 2696](#) passed on a short form vote, 18-0.

Senator Taylor was recognized for [HF 2337](#). He presented a subcommittee report and gave opening comments. There

was no discussion on the bill. Senator Taylor moved the bill. [HF 2337](#) passed on a short form vote, 18-0.
