Senator Kraayenbrink turned the chair over to Senator Zumbach. Senator Zumbach recognized Senator Kraayenbrink for the subcommittee report and opening remarks on [SSB 3184](#). Senator Zumbach entertained comments from the floor. Senator Petersen was recognized for comment. Senator Kraayenbrink was recognized for closing comments and moved [SSB 3184](#). A short form vote was requested. [SSB 3184](#) passed with 12 yeas; 6 nays (Petersen, Blake, Donahue, Dotzler, Staed, Winckler); 4 excused (Bousselot, Garrett, Knox, Rowley) and moved to the Calendar as a committee bill.

Senator Zumbach recognized Senator Kraayenbrink for the subcommittee report and opening remarks on [SSB 3185](#). Senator Zumbach entertained comments from the floor. Senator Petersen was recognized for comment. Senator Kraayenbrink was recognized for closing comments and moved [SSB 3185](#). A short form vote was requested. Senator Kraayenbrink recognized Senator Gruenhagen for the subcommittee report and opening remarks on [SSB 3188](#). Senator Kraayenbrink entertained comments from the floor. Senator Dotzler was recognized for comment. Senator Kraayenbrink recognized Senator Gruenhagen for closing comments on [SSB 3188](#). Senator Gruenhagen moved the bill. A short form vote was requested. [SSB 3188](#) passed with 13 yeas; 6 nays (Petersen, Blake, Donahue, Dotzler, Staed, Winckler); 3 excused (Garrett, Knox, Rowley) and moved to the Calendar as a committee bill.

Senator Kraayenbrink recognized Senator Shipley for the subcommittee report and opening remarks on [SSB 3190](#). Senator Kraayenbrink entertained comments from the floor. Senators Staed and Koelker were recognized for comment. Senator Kraayenbrink recognized Senator Shipley for closing comments on [SSB 3190](#). Senator Shipley moved the bill. A short form vote was requested. short form vote was requested. [SSB 3192](#) passed with 13 yeas; 6 nays (Petersen, Blake, Donahue, Dotzler, Staed, Winckler); 3 excused (Garrett, Knox, Rowley) and moved to the Calendar as a committee bill.

Senator Kraayenbrink recognized Senator Warme for the subcommittee report and opening remarks on [SF 2462](#).

Senator Warme introduced Amendment 3904. Senator Kraayenbrink entertained comments from the floor. Senator Winckler was recognized for comment. Senator Warme was recognized for closing comments and moved amendment 3904. A short form vote was requested. Amendment 3904 passed with 13 yeas; 6 nays (Petersen, Blake, Donahue, Dotzler, Staed, Winckler); 3 excused (Garrett, Knox, Rowley).

Back on [SF 2462](#) as amended. Senator Kraayenbrink entertained comments from the floor. Senator Winckler was recognized for comment. Senator Kraayenbrink recognized Senator Warme for closing co. A short form vote was requested. [SF 2462](#) as amended passed with 13 yeas; 6 nays (Petersen, Blake, Donahue, Dotzler, Staed, Winckler); 3 excused (Garrett, Knox, Rowley) and moved to the Calendar as a committee bill.

Senator Kraayenbrink recognized Senator Warme for the subcommittee report and opening remarks on [SSB 3193](#).

Senator Kraayenbrink entertained comments from the floor. Senators Dotzler, Donahue, Petersen, and Dawson were recognized for comments. Senator Kraayenbrink recognized Senator Warme for closing comments on [SSB 3193](#).

Senator Warme moved the bill. Short form vote was requested. [SSB 3193](#) passed with 13 yeas; 6 nays (Petersen, Blake, Donahue, Dotzler, Staed, Winckler); 3 excused (Garrett, Knox, Rowley) and moved to the Calendar as a committee bill.
