There was discussion. Rep. Gjerde provided closing comments, moved the amendment, and requested a roll call vote. With 8 yeas (Representatives Jacoby, Gjerde, Judge, Kurth, McBurney, Wessel-Kroeschell, Wichtendahl, Wilson) and 17 nays (Representatives Nordman, Hermanson, Behn, Bloomingdale, Boden, Gustoff, Holt, Hora, Johnson, C., Jones, Lundgren, Meggers, Siegrist, Vondran, Wills, J., Wulf, Young), the amendment fails. There was further discussion. Rep. Jones moved the bill. With a vote of 22 yeas (Representatives Nordman, Hermanson, Behn, Bloomingdale, Boden, Gjerde, Gustoff, Holt, Hora, Johnson, C., Jones, Judge, Lundgren, McBurney, Meggers, Siegrist, Vondran, Wichtendahl, Wills, J., Wilson, Wulf, Young) to 3 nays (Representatives Jacoby, Kurth, Wessel-Kroeschell) the bill passes.

Chairman Nordman recognized Rep. Wulf for opening remarks on [HF 2709](#). Rep. Wulf provided opening comments. There was discussion. Rep. Wulf provided closing remarks and moved the bill. With a vote of 18 yeas (Representatives Nordman, Hermanson, Jacoby, Behn, Bloomingdale, Boden, Holt, Hora, Johnson, C., Kurth, Lundgren, McBurney, Meggers, Siegrist, Vondran, Wessel-Kroeschell, Wills, J., Wulf) to 7 nays (Representatives Gjerde, Gustoff, Jones, Judge, Wichtendahl, Wilson, Young) the bill passes. With no further business, Rep. Lundgren moved to adjourn at 2:53 PM.
