Chairman Nordman called the meeting to order at 9:57 AM.

Roll was called. Representative Wilson was excused.

Minutes were approved from last meeting.

Chairman Nordman recognized Rep. Holt for opening comments on [HF 92](#). Rep. Holt provided opening comments and stated there was an amendment. Chairman Nordman recognized Rep. Holt for opening comments on amendment .3363. There was discussion. Rep. Holt moved the amendment and it was passed by a voice vote. There was discussion on the bill as amended. Rep. Holt moved the bill as amended. With a vote of 23 yeas (Representatives Nordman, Hermanson, Jacoby, Behn, Boden, Gjerde, Gustoff, Holt, Hora, Johnson, C., Jones, Judge, Kurth, Lundgren, McBurney, Meggers, Siegrist, Vondran, Wessel-Kroeschell, Wichtendahl, Wills, J., Wulf, Young) to 0 nays and 2 excused (Representatives Bloomingdale and Wilson), the bill passes out of committee.

Chairman Nordman recognized Rep. Siegrist. Rep. Siegrist asked for unanimous consent to move the committee into a subcommittee of the whole which was approved. Rep. Siegrist provided opening comments on [HSB 690](#). There was no discussion and the bill was passed out of subcommittee by a voice vote. Rep. Siegrist moved to adjourn the subcommittee and it was adjourned by a unanimous consent, moving it back to full committee.

Jacoby provided closing comments on the amendment with the request for a division and record. With a vote of 7 yeas (Representatives Jacoby, Gjerde, Judge, Kurth, McBurney, Wessel-Kroeschell, Wichtendahl) to 17 nays (Representatives Nordman, Hermanson, Behn, Bloomingdale, Boden, Gustoff, Holt, Hora, Johnson, C., Jones, Lundgren, Meggers, Siegrist, Vondran, Wills, J., Wulf, Young) and 1 excused (Representative Wilson), the amendment fails. Rep. Lundgren moved the bill as amended. With a vote of 24 yeas (Representatives Nordman, Hermanson, Jacoby, Behn, Bloomingdale, Boden, Gjerde, Gustoff, Holt, Hora, Johnson, C., Jones, Judge, Kurth, Lundgren, McBurney, Meggers, Siegrist, Vondran, Wessel-Kroeschell, Wichtendahl, Wills, J., Wulf, Young) to 0 nays and 1 excused (Representative Wilson), the bill passes out of committee as amended

With a vote of 24 yeas (Representatives Nordman, Hermanson, Jacoby, Behn, Bloomingdale, Boden, Gjerde, Gustoff, Holt, Hora, Johnson, C., Jones, Judge, Kurth, Lundgren, McBurney, Meggers, Siegrist, Vondran, Wessel-Kroeschell, Wichtendahl, Wills, J., Wulf, Young) to 0 nays and 1 excused (Representative Wilson), the bill passes out of committee.
