Chairman Thomson called the committee meeting to order at 9:25 AM. Roll call was taken, with 0 absent and 0 excused. The minutes from the previous meeting were approved with no changes or objections. Chairman Thomson made a motion to move the full committee into subcommittee of the whole, which was approved by a majority voice vote. Representative Holt was recognized for opening comments on [HSB 780](#), discussion was had between committee members and members of the public. With no further discussion, Representative Holt moved [HSB 780](#) out of subcommittee of the whole on a record roll call vote of 7 ayes (Representatives Thomson, Shipley, Boden, Collins, Fett, Holt, Lawler), and 4 nays (Representatives McBurney, Gjerde, Jacoby, Ramirez).

Rep. Holt moved the subcommittee of the whole be dissolved. Majority voice vote returned the subcommittee of the whole to full committee. Both parties then went to caucus at 9:50 AM.

Chairman Thomson returned the meeting to order at 11:47AM and immediately called the committee to recess until the conclusion of floor debate in the House of Representatives.

Chairman Thomson returned the meeting to order at 1:46 PM and immediately recessed the meeting until conclusion of both party caucuses.

Chairman Thomson returned the committee meeting back to order at 1:54PM.

Chairman Thomson recognized Representative Holt for opening comments on [HSB 780](#). Chairman Thomson recognized Representatives, Ramirez, McBurney, Lawler, and Boden for comments and discussion on [HSB 780](#).

Chairman Thomson made comments. Chairman Thomson recognized Representative Holt for closing comments on [HSB 780](#). Representative Holt moved [HSB 780](#) on a record roll call vote of 8 ayes (Representatives Thomson, Shipley, Boden, Collins, Fett, Gjerde, Holt, Lawler), and 3 nays (Representatives McBurney, Jacoby, Ramirez). [HSB 780](#) passes as a committee bill.

Chairman Thomson recognized Representative Jacoby for questions about Tyler Technologies. Discussion followed. With no further business to come before the committee, Representative Jacoby motioned for adjournment, and the meeting adjourned at 2:29 PM.
