Representative Shomshor called the meeting to order. Clerk called roll and minutes from last meeting were approved.

Representative Shomshor introduced and assigned the following bills to subcommittees:

Representative Shomshor called up two bills for consideration by the committee: SF 572 and HF 902.

Representative Kelley gave opening remarks on SF 572. An amendment (572.202) was offered and passed by a voice vote. Representative Kelley offered closing remarks and a roll call vote was taken for SF 572. SF 572 passed with 23 ayes-0 nays and 2 absent.

Representative Frevert gave opening remarks on HF 902. An amendment (902.701) was offered and passed by a voice vote. Discussion on the bill followed. Representative Frevert offered closing remarks and a roll call vote was taken for HF 902. HF 902 passed with 23 ayes-0 nays and 2 absent.

Representative Shomshor recognized the Iowa Department of Revenue for a presentation. Director Mark Schuling presented and distributed the annual report. Jim McNulty, Victoria Daniels and Dave Casey were also in attendance.

Questions and discussion followed the presentation. Seeing no other business to come before the committee, Representative Frevert moved to adjourn.
