The Justice Sysytem Appropriations Subcommittee met at Fort Des Moines. Sally Kramer is director of the 5th Judicial District CBC. They shared that there have been 204,000 "events" relating to GPS monitoring since its inception on 10/27/06. Director Kramer said that probably over 90% are events that do not deal with offender non-compliance. There have been a total of 937 offenders monitored thus far. Currently there are 500+.

Senator Hancock asked for a report relating to the GPS "events" and how many are actually offender non-compliance and how many are false alerts, for example. Senator Hancock also asked for a report regarding the newly hired program manager.
