Senator Schoenjahn called the meeting to order at 1:05 P.M. Minutes were approved from the February 11th meeting. Senator Schoenjahn turned the chair over to Senator Appel who then recognized Senator Schoenjahn to take up amendment SSB 3097.703. A brief discussion took place.

Senator Appel recognized Senator Wood to take up amendment SSB 3097.704. After a brief discussion, Senator Wood withdrew the amendment.

Senator Appel recognized Senator Schoenjahn to take up SSB 3097, an act concerning state and local measures for preparing a student for a career or for postsecondary education, including a statewide core curriculum for school districts and accredited nonpublic schools and a state-designated career information and decision-making system. A brief discussion took place.

Senator Appel called for a Democratic caucus. Senator Mulder called for a Republican caucus. The Education Committee recessed at 1:25 P.M. The Education Committee reconvened at 1:55 P.M.

Senator Appel recognized Senator Schoenjahn to continue with amendment SSB 3097.703. Short form was called. 13 senators voting aye and Senators Ziemann and McKinley voting nay.

Senator Appel recognized Senator Schoenjahn to again take up bill SSB 3097.

Senator Appel recognized Senator Mulder who made a motion to defer on SSB 3097 until Monday, February 18th.
