HSB 740 An act relating to county compensation boards by modifying the composition of the boards, requiring certain information to be considered by a board, and providing a procedure for preparation and adoption of a compensation schedule in certain years. HF 2211 A bill for an act relating to compensation paid to county supervisors. Hoffman - Ch, Bukta, Gaskill, M., Kaufmann, Taylor, D.

HF 2345 A bill for an act relating to the review of subdivision plats and zoning changes by a local board of health or a county sanitarian. Kressig - Ch, Deyoe, Schueller

HF 2387 A bill for an act relating to the use of automated traffic enforcement systems by cities, authorizing civil penalties, and providing an effective date. Huser - Ch, Deyoe, Lykam

The Chair recognized Representative Thomas for HSB 647 An Act relating to rules for the discharge of wastewater from water well drilling sites. Opening remarks were made. Representative Thomas was recognized for Amendment 703. Opening remarks were made.
