



Next, Chairperson Swaim recognized Representative Schueller for opening comments on HSB 707. Chairperson Swaim then recognized Representative Schueller for opening comments on Amendment 501. Amendment 501 to HSB 707 passed by a voice vote. The floor was opened for discussion on HSB 707 as amended. Following discussion, Representative Schueller moved passage of HSB 707. HSB 707 passed the committee 21-0. Chairperson Swaim announced that HSB 707, having received sufficient votes for passage, would pass to the Floor of the House.

Chairperson Swaim recognized Representative Schueller for opening comments on HSB 708. Chairperson Swaim then recognized Representative Schueller for opening comments on Amendment 301. Amendment 301 to HSB 708 passed by a voice vote. Representative Schueller then moved passage of HSB 708 as amended. HSB 708 passed the committee 21-0. Chairperson Swaim announced that HSB 708, having received sufficient votes for passage, would pass to the Floor of the House.

Chairperson Swaim then recognized Representative Olson, who asked for unanimous consent to consider HF 2300 in subcommittee as a whole. There were no objections. Chairperson Swaim recognized Representative Olson for opening comments on HF 2300. Following discussion, HF 2300 passed out of subcommittee as a whole by a voice vote. Then, motion was made and duly passed to dissolve the subcommittee as a whole and return to committee. Then Chairperson Swaim recognized Representative Olson for opening remarks on HF 2300. Following committee discussion, Representative Olson moved passage of HF 2300. HF 2300 passed the committee 13-8. Chairperson Swaim announced that HF 2300, having received sufficient votes for passage, would pass to the Floor of the House as a committee bill.

There being no further business to come before the committee, Representative Anderson moved to arise.
